Given or "earned":

- Gen. 2: 19 - 20
Man names the animals

- Matt. 1: 21 - 25
Jesus is given a name

Inherited/ Marriage:

- Isaiah 7: 13 - 14
Prophecy of virgin birth

- Matt. 1
Lineage of Christ

What do names signify or reflect?

Circumstances / purposes of birth:

- Hosea 1: 4, 6, 9
Hosea's children are named

- Gen. 25: 21 - 25
Esau and Jacob are born
(came forth red and trickster)

Relationship / Lineage:

- Matt. 1
Traces Christ's lineage to David

- Rom. 8: 14 - 15
We are adopted and can cry out,
"Abba, Father"

Character / attributes:

Character - the total of what a person thinks, feels, and does by which he is judged

Attribute - a quality or feature that is thought of as a natural part of a person or thing
